
**FEEDBACK ANALYSIS REPORT
Feedback on Curriculum by Teachers**

Academic Year: 2021-2022


A total of 52 members of the teaching staff provided their feedback on curriculum for the year 2021-22, opinion of the faculty on various aspects of the curriculum are analysed and summarised as follows:

1. Majority of the teachers (71.2 %) rated as good for the statement that the curriculum prescribed for students are well balanced in terms of balance in teaching goals as well as expectations from students. Whereas 19.2 per cent rated the existing curriculum is excellent in balancing in teaching goals and expectations from students and 4.7 per cent rated as average and 1.9 per cent as fair.
2. Majority of the teachers (59.6 %) rated as good for statement that the curriculum prescribed for the students is/are sufficient to bridge the gap between theory and practice in homoeopathy system as medicine, it is rated as excellent by 26.9 per cent, 3.8 per cent of the teachers rated as fair and the remaining 9.6 per cent rated as poor.
3. Most of the teachers (94.2 %) opined that the existing curriculum meant for the BHMS and M.D. (Hom.) are possible to complete within the stipulated period of time, however, 5.8 per cent of them opined that additional classes are to be arranged to complete the curriculum within the stipulated time.
4. Exactly 50 per cent of the teachers agree that sufficient books and reference materials are available in the library for the topics mentioned in the syllabus, 40.4 per cent of them rated as excellent for the availability of textbooks and reference materials available in the library, and availability of materials is rated as poor by 7.7 per cent.
5. Regarding the evaluation methods mentioned in the curriculum is sufficient for providing proper assessment; majority of the teachers (63.5 %) rated as good, 19.2 per cent as excellent, 13.2 per cent as average and 3.8 per cent as fair.
6. 92.3 per cent of the teachers agree that the existing syllabus prescribed for BHMS / M.D.(Hom.) is/are a challengeable one whereas only 5.8 per cent opined that the syllabus is inadequate and they expect something more.

7. Centum per cent of the teachers agree that transparency is followed in the institutional evaluation system is adequate enough.
8. Ninety per cent of the teachers opined that the curriculum prescribed for BHMS and M.D.(Hom.) is adequate enough to develop skill in case taking and prescriptions, 5.8 per cent opined it is inadequate and 3.8 per cent as irrelevant.
9. Majority of the teachers (94.2 %) teachers opined that the existing curriculum is adequate enough for integration of ICT whereas the remaining 5.8 per cent of teachers opined that it is inadequate to accommodate ICT integration.
