FEEDBACK ANALYSIS REPORT

Feedback on Curriculum by Alumni

Academic Year: 2021-2022

A total of 141 alumni have provided their feedback on curriculum for 2021-22 through online. Their feedback are analysed and summarised as follows:


1. Among the 141 respondents, 64 (65.4%) of them are presently practising Homoeopathy through establishing clinic on their own, 46 respondents (32.6%) are working as Assistant Professors/Professors in Homoeopathic Colleges, 12.1% of them are currently pursuing higher education in Homoeopathy, 9.9% of them are working in Government Institution and the remaining 9.9% of students in other fields.
2. Opinion of alumni on curriculum in their respective year revealed that 44.4 per cent of them rated as excellent, 34.8 per cent rated as very good, and 23.4 per cent rated as good. There is only 1.4 per cent of alumni rated the curriculum as average. Hence, it is interpreted that almost all alumni except 1.4 percent rated their curriculum as good.
3. Regarding the quality of education imparted by the institution, only 0.7 per cent of the alumni rated as average remaining i.e., 99.3 per cent of them rated it as atleast as good. Among the majority, 45.4 per cent rated as excellent, 37.6 per cent rated as very good and 16.3 per cent rated as good.
4. For content delivery also similar trend is prevailed. One third of the respondents rated method of content delivery in their alma mater is excellent, the same is responded as very good by 43.3 per cent and rated as good by 27.7 percent. Only 0.7 per cent of them rated as average.
5. On the extent of fulfilling the course expectations on curriculum during their study, 32.6 per cent of them rated that their expectation are fulfilled at maximum and at excellent level; 39.7 per cent rated as very good and 24.1 per cent of them rated as good. Only 4 per cent of them rated that their expectations are fulfilled only at average level. Thus, it is interpreted that 94 per cent of the alumni opined that their expectations are fulfilled.
6. Similarly, the extent of curriculum matches with current trends in the subject, 29.8 per cent of the respondents rated that curriculum matches with current trends at excellent level, 36.9

per cent rated it as very good, 30.5 per cent rated as good and the remaining 4 per cent rated as average. Here also 96 per cent of the alumni opined that the existing curriculum matches with current trends.

7. As far as new skills learnt during the course of study, 25.5 per cent agreed that they learnt new skills during their course at an excellent level whereas 34.8 per cent rated as very good and 28.4 per cent rated as good. The same is rated as average by 7.1 per cent of the respondents and rated as poor by 4.3 per cent
8. Opinion of alumni on relevance of the degree and present job, 39.7 per cent rated as relevant at an excellent level, the same is rated as very good by 36.2 per cent, 22.7 per cent rated as good. However, 1.4 per cent of them opined that it is only at an average level.
9. Initiatives of the institution to improve the competencies of the students through innovative teaching-learning methods, seminars and workshops, majority of them (97.9%) rated as good. Among those who responded as good, 39.7 per cent rated as excellent and 36.7 per cent rated as very good. Two per cent of them rated as average.
10. Regarding developmental activities carried out by the institution for over all development of the students is rated as excellent by 36.2 per cent, very good by 32.6 per cent and 24.8 per cent as good. Only 2.8 per cent of the alumni rated as poor.
11. On motivation provided by the faculty to pursue research oriented higher education in Homoeopathy, 33.3 per cent of the alumni opined that the motivation provided by the faculty is at an excellent level whereas 39 per cent rated as very good and 20.6 per cent rated as good. However, there are 5.7 per cent of the alumni rated as average and only 1.4 per cent rated as poor.
12. Suggestions provided by the alumni are: conduct International and National Seminars with paper presentations in atleast once in a month from all departments; batch wise alumni meet; kindly invite alumni for CME programmes and seminars; Guest lecturers' classes for PG Classes and Skill development training to all students in PG Department.
