No.	Feedback	Action Taken
1	Syllabus covered by the departments was 55 -70 % as per 21% of students & 4% marked that less than 55% was coverd	The Principal has instructed all the Heads of Departments to look into the matter for any such reasons, and Departments were instructed to cover the syllabus within the stipulated period by using different methods of teaching & evaluation. The assignment & seminar topics scheduled to them shall be on the topics which could not be covered in the permissible schedule. Self-Learning methods shall be adopted for the same which would create an enthusiasm in using the Library at its best.
2	Regarding the teachers ability to communicate 30 % marked as satisfactory & 6 % as ineffective.	Principal in a meeting has once again put forward the agenda on the matter and have suggested the Faculty to look into the matter seriously. It was again reminded to all the teachers that they should communicate with students in English, especially while Lecturing & also in OPDs & bedside clinics.
3	Teachers approach is always indifferent & sometimes rude (40 %)	Principal in a meeting has once again put forward the agenda on the matter and have suggested the entire faculty by the Principal to show love & caring feel towards them.
4	Internal assessment evaluations are sometimes unfair as per information from 43 % students & 9% informed that it was usually unfair	The Principals meeting with the Faculty, and instructed the examination cell to once again look into the area of unfairness by meeting all the HoDs, verifying the evaluation pattern, discuss with students and if found to exist shall be reported to the Head of Department / Principal.
5	18 % opinion that the teachers give feed back without any comments after an Internal exam & 12% marked that it was late.	The members of Faculty are again requested by the Principal to have a better interaction with the students after a Term Test or Monthly Test. The teachers are asked to give the students information on how to answer a question or what is lacking in an answer they have written, so that he/she will be able to make necessary improvement during the next examinations.

7	Discussion or comments on students assignment are not done by teachers as per 31% of students	The members of Faculty are once again reminded by the Principal to have a better interaction with the students on Assignment. The teachers are asked to properly comment on how to write an assignment or what is lacking in the assignment they have presented, so that he/she will be able to make necessary improvement thereafter.
8	Other suggestions: Tests can be conducted at the end of every Chapter	The Formative evaluation introduced by the Examination cell has already instructed to conduct monthly test papers & quiz programmes, which shall help the students to learn the portions in ease.
