Feedback Analysis

Feedback from Teachers 2016-17

Feedback from the teachers and their satisfaction towards curriculum, teaching, learning, evaluation and infrastructure are collected regularly and analysed as follows:

- Regarding satisfaction of the teachers towards the course and syllabus taught by them have good balance between theory and application was 'agree' by 62.2 per cent, 'strongly agree' by 35.6 per cent and the remaining 2.2 per cent of teachers 'neither disagree nor agree'.
- Regarding the objectives of the syallabi, 57.8 per cent of the teachers 'agree' that they are well defined, 31.1 per cent of them 'strongly agree', 6.7 per cent 'neither disagree nor agree' and 4.4 per cent 'disagree'.
- On relevance of books and reference materials to cover the entire syllabi: 48.9 per cent 'strongly agree', 42.2 per cent 'agree', 4.4 per cent 'neither disagree or agree' and 4.4 per cent 'disagree'.
- 4. 66.7 per cent of the teachers 'strongly agree' that there is increase in their interest, knowledge and perspective in their subject areas taught by them, 26.7 per cent just 'agree', 4.4 per cent 'neither disagree or agree' and 2.2 per cent 'strongly disagree'.
- Regarding freedom of teachers to adopt new techniques and strategies for teaching:
 62.2 per cent of them 'strongly agree' and 35.6 per cent just 'agree' it.
- Majority of the teachers (51.1 per cent) 'strongly agree' that freedoms are given to them to adopt new techniques and strategies for assessment and evaluation of students, 40 percent of them 'agree' and 6.7 per cent 'neither disagree nor agree'.
- Regarding test and examinations conducted well in time in the institution, 57. 8 per cent 'strongly agree', 37.8 per cent 'agree' and 4.4 per cent 'disagree'.
- Regarding the availability of prescribed books in the library, 66.7 per cent 'strongly agree', 28.9 per cent 'agree', 2.2 per cent 'disagree' and 2.2 per cent neither disagree nor agree'.
- Teachers view on convenience of college environment for teaching and research is that 48.9 per cent 'strongly agree', 48.9 per cent 'agree' and 2.2 per cent 'neither disagree nor agree'.
- 10. Opinion of teachers on teacher friendliness of college administration: 55.6 per cent 'strongly agree', 37.8 per cent 'agree' and 6.7 per cent 'neither disagree nor agree'.
- 11. Regarding the provision of opportunities and support to the faculty to update their knowledge, skill and qualifications by the management, majority of the teachers (68.9 per cent) 'strongly agree', 28.9 per cent 'agree' and 2.2 per cent 'neither disagree nor agree'.
- 12. Opinion of faculty on the provision of seed money and other perks for updating knowledge and skills, 48.9 per cent 'strongly agree', 40 per cent 'agree', 6.7 per cent 'neither disagree nor agree' and 4.4 per cent 'disagree'.

- 13. Majority (55.6 per cent) of the teachers 'agree' that facilities for ICT in the college are adequate, 26.7 per cent 'strongly agree', 13.3 per cent 'neither disagree nor agree' and 4.4 per cent disagree.
- 14. Regarding availability of sufficient space in college canteen/cafeteria for teachers: 44.9 per cent 'strongly agree', 37.8 per cent 'agree', 11.1 per cent 'disagree' and 6.7 per cent 'neither disagree nor agree'.
- 15. Regarding maintenance and cleaning of Toilets/Wash room in the college: 42.2 per cent of them 'agree', 37.8 per cent 'strongly agree', 11.1 per cent 'neither disagree nor agree' and 8.9 per cent 'disagree'.

16. Regarding the maintenance and cleaning of classroom: 46.7 per cent 'strongly agree', 35.6 per cent 'agree', 11.1 per cent disagree and the remaining neither disagree nor disagree.
